1) Fees can be paid annually or monthly, via cash, check, automatic withdrawal and /or credit card. Credit card payments will be assessed a \$5 additional charge due to the increased cost of processing.

2) Families using automatic withdrawal must pay the first month plus registration fee at time of registration; thereafter withdrawal will take place on the 15th of the month for each subsequent month (October through March).

3) A discount on fees is provided for families with multiple swimmers in the competitive program only. Full fees are applied to the swimmer at the highest program level; fees for each subsequent competitive swimmer in the same family will be reduced by \$5.

4) EMAC will begin its competitive training season on September 10th and continue thru the end of Junior Olympics/ Regionals or Zones in March or early April of 2009.

5) Senior fees will be paid for the two months starting September 10th and concluding November 9, 2008 upon registration. Fees will be required again after the high school state meet for all swimmers remaining in the water.

* A non-refundable registration fee of \$75 per swimmer is due at time of registration to cover annual USA Swimming registration, insurance, and administrative fees.

EMMAUS AQUATIC CLUB—COMPETITIVE RULES & REGULATIONS

1) The Club cannot be held responsible for any injuries to its members during travel to and from practices and meets. The club is not responsible for any injuries or property damage occurring at any facility or grounds. The members of EMAC are responsible for all property damage which is committed by themselves or their children.

2) All competitive members must be registered with USA Swimming/United States Diving under EMAC's name & will abide by the Club's rules and regulations in the USA Swimming/United States Diving rules and regulations.

3) **All seasonal/competitive club members are required to participate in at least one Swim-A-Thon per year. ***As long as all members meet minimum Swim-A-Thon requirements other fundraisers will not be **mandatory**. This makes the burden of fund raising as simple as possible for both the Club and the members. Age Group Swimmers are required to raise a minimum of \$50, Senior Group Swimmers are required to raise a minimum of \$100.

4) A member may be expelled from the Club for:

- a. Non-payment of dues, fees or expenses.
- b. Behavior at any facility or meets that is detrimental to the development of the Club or other members.
- c. Failure to meet minimum fundraising requirements.
- d. Upon recommendation of the Coaches or Facility Manager.

5) A swimmer will be ***immediately expelled*** from EMAC for the consumption of alcohol or a controlled substance at practice, a meet, during travel to or travel from a meet, or any EMAC sponsored and/or related activity.
